Dear Parents,

The 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club provides no-cost lodging for medically and financially qualified patients receiving cancer treatment in central Arkansas. The Angels of Hope program is a great opportunity for young ladies entering their junior year of high school to work directly with our patients and other cancer related organizations.

**Program Details:** The Angels of Hope Program offers your daughter the opportunity to grow in compassion, understanding, responsibility and cancer education. Angels of Hope members will complete 25 hours of service by participating in planned activities such as serving dinner to the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club Lodge patients and caregivers, attending a Pink Party and volunteering at CARTI's Little Rock office. They also learn the importance of serving others in their community and cancer awareness. The goal of the 20th Century Club in providing this program is to create a desire in young women to make a difference in their community through volunteering. In addition to the educational and volunteer opportunities, social activities with parents are included. The total cost of the program is \$3,000. After your deposit of \$500, the remaining \$2,500 balance is payable in full by September 15, 2025. This amount includes 3 tickets to the Hope Ball. Program payments, minus the value of the Hope Ball tickets, are considered donations to the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club of Little Rock. The Angels of Hope program is limited to a total of 30 participants. Daughters and granddaughters of 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club members are given priority consideration and have completed their application process; thus, we have a very limited number of available spots remaining. The highlight of the program is the presentation of the Angels of Hope at the Hope Ball on March 7, 2026, in formal white gowns and opera length gloves at the Arkansas Statehouse Convention Center.

**Gown Approval and Photo Shoot:** There will be two photo shoots in the fall; each Angel will register for one photo shoot at the August Parent Orientation. The Angels will be photographed in white evening gowns for a group photo to be included in the February issue of *Inviting Arkansas*. Photography requirements:

- Approval of white evening gown by Angels of Hope Chair by date set for Angel's photo shoot
- Financial obligations must be current to be included in group photo

**Application Process:** Enrollment in the Angels of Hope program is by random drawing. To be entered in the program, candidates must complete all forms included with this invitation letter and return those plus a wallet size or 4 X 6 size photo of the candidate **to Hogan Taylor, LLP**

**by 5:00 pm on Thursday, April 24th.** Candidates whose packets are received after the specified date and time and/or without all the required information will not be eligible for the random drawing. Due to current issues with the US mail delivery being delayed, be aware that you may hand deliver your packet to Hogan Taylor if you so choose. Representatives of Hogan Taylor, LLP will conduct the random drawing and provide the results to the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club by 5:00 pm on the business day following the packet due date. Immediately following the 1<sup>st</sup> random drawing, a second random drawing will be done to create an ordered alternate list. Those names will be withheld from the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club unless at some point they are needed. The 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club Executive Director will notify each candidates' parents via email as to whether their daughter was selected in the random drawing or not.

Parents of candidates selected by the random drawing will be notified via email of when the required \$500 deposit is due at the Lodge office. **DO NOT SEND PAYMENT AT THIS TIME.** If the deposit is received by the required date, the candidate's spot in the Angels of Hope program is secured. If the deposit is NOT received by the required date, the candidate will not be offered a spot in the Angels of Hope program. If a candidate or candidates selected by the random drawing declines to participate in the Angels of Hope program or fails to submit the required deposit by the due date, those spot(s) in the Angels of Hope program will become available to the candidates on the ordered alternate list.

# Angels of Hope Guidelines for Effective Participation 2025-2026

The Angels of Hope Program encourages each Angel to be responsible for organizing their schedule of activities in order to meet the program service requirements. We have found that the following guidelines below help to set the Angels up for success in the program. We ask that Parents and Angels review the guidelines below and sign the bottom of the form.

## Angels:

# Hope Ball 2025 is March 7, 2026

## Service Requirements: Deadline is February 20, 2026

25 hours of total volunteer service must be completed for presentation at the Hope Ball. The service year begins on June 1, 2025 and ends on February 20, 2026.

- A minimum of **5 hours** at CARTI (Tour de Rock, CARTI Cancer Center &/or Sugar Plum Ball)
- Must attend **1 Angels of Hope hosted Lodge dinner & bingo party** (Beach Party, Halloween Party or Winter Party)
- Must attend **1 Monday night Lodge dinner** hosted by the 20th Century Club's Lodge Manager
- Must attend **1 Tuesday night Lodge dinner** hosted by the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club Members
- Must attend **1 Wednesday night Lodge dinner** hosted by the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club Members
- Must attend **1 Thursday night Lodge dinner** by the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Club Members
- Must **attend "Pink Party"** for breast cancer detection and awareness

**Service Above Self Award:** Any Angel completing 75 more service hours than the required 25 service hours (for a total of 100 hours) is eligible to receive the Service Above Self Award presented at the Hope Ball.
